

AWARDS AND ELIGIBILITY

Diplôme Culinaire D'Hotelier

This award is presented to students who have successfully completed Stage 1 & 2 of the Le Cordon Bleu Bachelor of Business (International Hotel Management or International Restaurant Management).

Students are required to complete the academic elements of Kitchen Operations Management and Food & Beverage Service within Stage 1, along with the required 600 hours of Industry Placement in Stage 2.

Students who have been granted Academic Credit /Recognition of Prior Learning in any of the aforementioned academic elements will be ineligible (unless completed in a Le Cordon Bleu Culinary qualification).

Pins

Bachelor of Business

Bronze, Silver and Gold Pins are awarded to Bachelor students in recognition of their academic journey taken while studying with Le Cordon Bleu.

The Bronze Pin is awarded in recognition of completing the first year of studies (Stage 1 and Stage 2). Students who have been granted Academic Credit /Recognition of Prior Learning for an entire stage, or have not successfully completed Stage 1 or 2 will not receive a pin.

The Silver Pin is awarded in recognition of completing the second year of studies (Stage 3 and Stage 4). Students who have been granted Academic Credit /Recognition of Prior Learning for an entire stage, or have not successfully completed Stage 3 or 4 will not receive a pin.

Students will receive their Gold Pin on successful completion of all academic studies during their Graduation Ceremony.

All students from Stage 1, 3 and 5 who are listed above as ineligible to receive a pin are still welcome to attend the ceremony.

Masters in International Hospitality Management

Silver and Gold Pins are awarded to Masters Students in recognition of their academic journey taken while studying at Le Cordon Bleu.

The Silver Pin is awarded to students who have successfully completed all academic requirements of the Graduate Diploma In International Hospitality Management (1 year full time study).

Students will receive their Gold Pin on successful completion of all academic studies during their Graduation Ceremony.
